## Included in the Box

- USB Bulkhead
- Waterproof Bulkhead Cap # 9104.7 (installed)
- Hyper-Flex USB 4.0 Cable
- · Silicone lubricant 1cc tube

## **Important Notices**

- » Take the housing to depth without a camera installed the first time after installing this product.
- » Do not submerge without a waterproof bulkhead cap attached.
- » Always attach a waterproof bulkhead cap when not in use.
- » High-speed charging and data transfer requires the use of a high quality USB Type-C version 3.0 or above.
- » Some cameras prevent the charging of off-brand batteries (i.e. Promaster) via the USB connection.

## **Installation and Use**

#### Installing the Bulkhead

- 1. Carefully remove the M16 accessory port plug using a large flat screwdriver.
- 2. Check that the sealing surface and o-ring on the bulkhead are clean. Put a very light coating of lubricant on the visible surface of the o-ring.

- Thread the bulkhead into the housing's M16 accessory port being careful not to cross-thread.
- Use an 11/16" wrench to carefully tighten down the bulkhead just until it touches the case. Do not overtighten.
- **5.** Attach the waterproof bulkhead cap.
- **6.** Vacuum test the housing.
- 7. Take the housing to depth without a camera installed to test for leaks.

#### Using with a Camera

- Attach one end of the included Hyper-Flex USB-C cable to the bulkhead connector on the inside of the housing.
- **2.** When installing the camera, attach the other end of the Hyper-Flex cable to the camera USB-C port.
- **3.** Remove the waterproof bulkhead cap to reveal the USB-C port for charging and data transfer.
- 4. Use a compatible USB Type-C version 3.0 or above cable (not included) between the housing and your computer, wall charger, or portable power bank.
- **5.** Follow the camera manufacturer's instructions for data transfer.
- » The inside of the port is red for a visual reminder that a cap must be in place before entering the water. If the red insert is visible, the bulkhead is not waterproof.
- » High-speed charging and data transfer requires the use of a high quality USB Type-C version 3.0 or above (not included).
- » Not all USB cables are bi-polar. If charging or data transfer doesn't occur, remove the cable on the outside of the housing, rotate 180°, and re-insert.

## **Maintenance and Storage**

#### **Post-Dive**

- 1. Submerge the fully assembled system in clean, fresh water after each use.
- **2.** Remove the system from the rinse tank and flush with running fresh water.
- 3. Dry the system with a clean, lint-free cloth.

**4.** Separate the cap from the bulkhead and lubricate the threads and o-ring(s) every 1-2 days during continuous use and prior to storage.
