





Initial Camera Settings (before placing camera in housing)

- Insert fully charged battery.
- Insert and format a SD or SDHC memory card.
- Move Mode Switch to setting for "P" Program Mode.
- In MENU (Change shooting settings):

Set AF Frame to "Center" and AF Frame Size to "Normal."

Set Digital Zoom to "Off."

Set AF Point Zoom to "Off" and Servo AF to "Off."

Set Continuous AF to "Off" and AF-assist Beam to "Off." A strobe focusing light is recommended to assist AF underwater.

In Flash Settings, set Red-Eye Corr. and Red-Eye Lamp to "Off."

Set i-Contrast to "Off."

Set Review image after shooting to "8 Seconds and Display Info to "Off." Set Blink Detection and Grid Lines to "Off"

Set IS Mode to "Continuous."

In MENU 🖁 (Change camera settings):

Set Date and Time.

Set Lens Retract to "1 min" and Eco Mode to "Off,"

Power Saving: Set Auto Power Down to "Off" and Display Off to "3 min."

- In FUNC./SET Menu:

Set Rec. Mode to "P" Program.

Set Drive Mode to "Single Shot."

Set Resolution to "L" 16M and Compression to "Fine."

Set Movie Quality to "1280."

Set Light Metering to "Center Weighted Avg."

Set White Balance to auto "AWB." If more accurate colors are desired, we recommend setting manual white balance underwater using a white slate or white sandy bottom. Manual white balance should be reset for each working depth due to color absorption caused by the water. When adding a UR-Pro color filter, reset manual white balance.

Set ISO to "200."

Set Flash to "On \$ Flash always fires."

Initial Camera Settings (continued)

 Enable Macro mode when shooting close-up subjects. If overexposure occurs, back away from the subject and zoom in slightly.
 If overexposure continues, use "-" exposure compensation.

External Accessory Lenses


W-20 and W-30 Wide-Angle Conversion Lenses

The front of the lens port accepts the Ikelite 6420 W-20, 6430 W-30, and other 67mm threaded wide angle or macro lenses without the need for an adapter. An external wide angle conversion lens increases angle of coverage so you can get closer to the subject while still fitting everything in the frame.

Moderate vignetting will occur at widest angle camera lens setting with these lenses. Zoom in to eliminate, or crop the image in post processing.

Bayonet mount lenses cannot be used with this housing.


Ikelite 6430 W-30 Conversion Lens
